

The Flying Moa Wiener Dog Derby 2019

Saturday 21 September 2019

Registration 10.00 – 10.30am. Race time 11am



Race: Each Dachshund will run 20 metres from one handler to the other handler at the finish line.

The winner of each heat will compete in a final race to determine the winning wiener.

Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers.

Participation will be limited to those who deliver their completed entry form and proof of vaccination by 11am Saturday 21 September

There will be races for two breeds. Wieners and Wannabe wieners. Wieners will race in miniature and standard divisions.

Race rules: Current vaccination records must be presented at time of check in

Two (2) race handlers (provided by entrant) are required for each Dachshund dog entry.

Keep your dog on a 6 ft. or shorter leash at all times, except when racing.

Handlers and owners will be responsible for cleaning up after their dog.

Dogs must be socialized with other dogs and people.

Dogs in heat should be left at home

Persons under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Owners must remove their dog and leave the race if their dog acts aggressively towards people, other dogs, poses a safety risk to others, or appears to be unhealthy

Any dog not checked in by 11:00 a.m. may be disqualified and replaced with an alternate.

Any dog not at the start line at the appointed time will be disqualified from competing in the race. This applies even if the dog was initially checked in on time but not present when needed for the race.

If your dog does not appear to meet breed standards, additional documentation may be required.

In the event of inclement weather, The Flying Moa reserves the right to reschedule the event.

During the heat races, one handler will be placed at the starting line with the dog and a second person (owner must bring second person) will be placed at the finish line. The individual on the finish line may encourage the dog to run to them in any way that they wish (i.e. wave a toy, call the dog, have a treat) but cannot cross the line or move toward the dog in any way. No excessive noisemakers (i.e. whistles, horns) are permitted.

The race will be 20 metres in length.

Judges will determine the final finish. All decisions of the judges shall be final.

Wiener wannabe requirements: All other breeds and mixed breeds must fit under the racing height sign to participate in the Wiener Wannabe race. Maximum height 35cm.

To enter via online entry, log onto www.flyingmoapub.co.nz to access the entry form.

Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis until all spots are filled. Entries may also be dropped off in person at The Flying Moa during normal business hours.

Picture taking and videos are strongly encouraged.

We also agree to abide by all of the rules of participation, and acknowledge that if we do not do so, The Flying Moa may cancel this entry. We further agree that this release and wavier is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by applicable law, and that if any provision hereof is held to be invalid or unenforceable: (1) the balance hereof shall continue in full force and effect; and (2) in lieu of such invalid or unenforceable provision, there shall be automatically added as part hereof a provision as close in terms to the invalid or unenforceable provision as to then make it valid and enforceable and accomplish the original intent and purpose of this release and waiver.
